### General Rules:

- The Chili Cook-Off will be held during the Guy Show at Canyon Crest Event Center September 25<sup>th</sup> 2010.
- Falls Brand Pork will be provided and must be used in each chili submitted for judging.
- Chili is defined as any kind of spicy, stew-like dish cooked with chili peppers, pork (required), other meat (optional), beans (optional). Various other spices and ingredients may be added with the exception of rice or pasta.
- Beans may be used in your chili; however you must indicate its inclusion in the name, e.g. "Chili with Beans."
- Chili must be cooked at the event with exception of beans which may be pre-cooked. Check-in and set-up for the event will start at 9:00 a.m.
- Chili should be ready for judging at 12:00 p.m. for the noon turn in time.
- Chili should be kept hot, by electric crock pots or camping type stoves. Electric connections will be provided if needed.
- Chili must be prepared from scratch, no commercial mixes.
- Chili must be prepared in a sanitary manner and you must be willing to sample your own chili.
- Minimum of 3 Gallons must be cooked.
- Only one judging cup per chili pot can be submitted
- Participants are responsible for cleaning their area after the event.

### What to bring:

- Cooking stove and fuel (propane or Coleman type).
- Cooking pot, utensils, paper towels, matches, ingredients for chili.
- Chairs (approx 10x10 ft area provided with a 6 foot table).
- Items for decorating area if desired.

### "Best Chili" will be blind judged on the following criteria by a panel of judges:

- Best use of Falls Brand Pork
- Flavor
- Texture/consistency
- Aroma
- Appearance/presentation of dish
- Aftertaste

### "People's Choice" Award rules:

- People in attendance will be given a raffle ticket to drop in the box of their favorite chili.
- The team with the most tickets in their box will win the people's choice award.

### "Best Presentation" rules:

- The purpose of this award is to engage your team in the presentation of the cooking space and the presentation of your chili.
- Participants will be given one 6 foot table in which to present their chili and may decorate their table and area as they wish.
- The award will be given to the team with the best overall presentation of their area, the chili, and their uniforms.
